Report by Paul Barette:

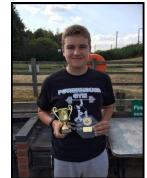

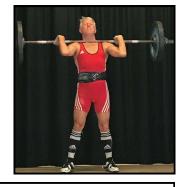
